

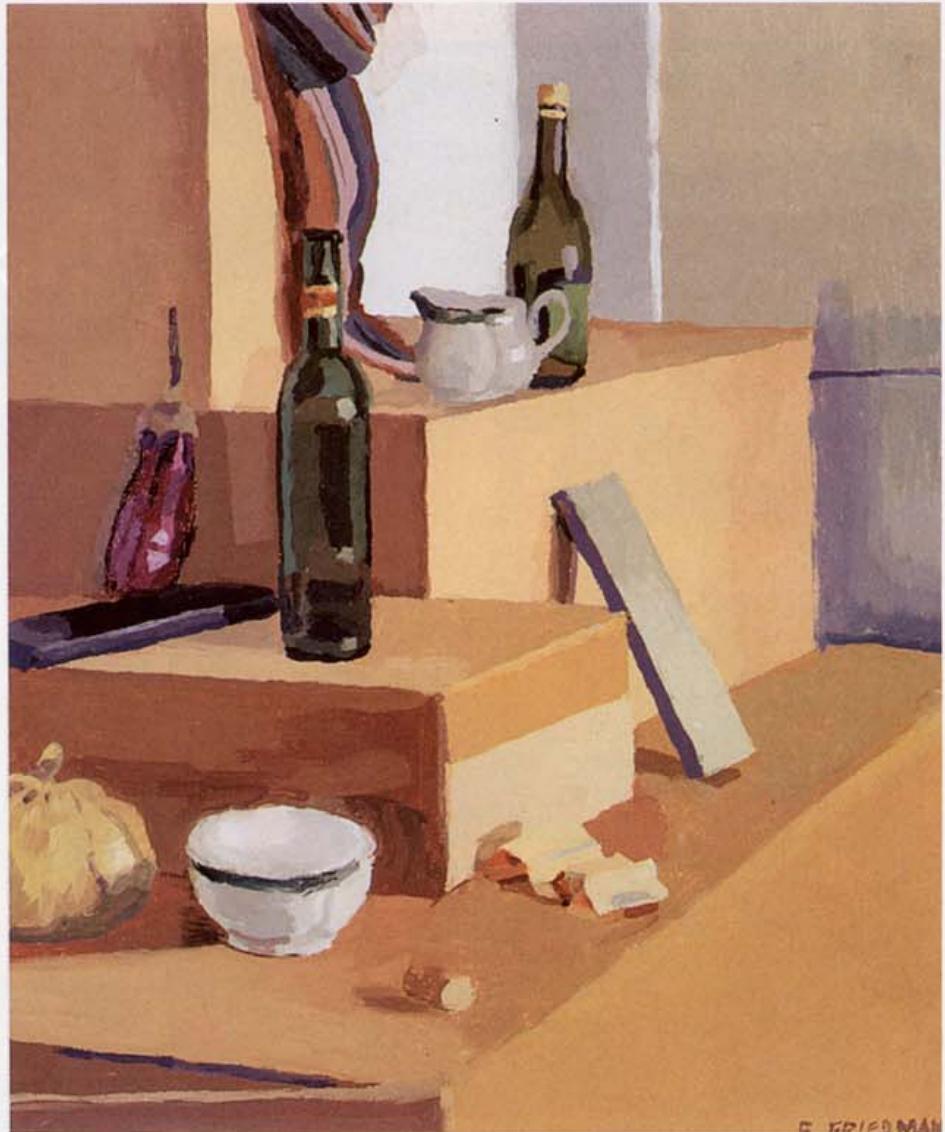
Quick Sketches

TABLETOP STILL-LIFE SHOW

A group devoted to still life, Zeuxis, has organized a traveling show featuring tabletop setups. Titled "Tabletop Arenas," the show will be on display in the following venues: The Art Gallery, University of New Hampshire, Durham, New Hampshire, September 8 through October 20; Cantor Fitzgerald Gallery, Haverford College, Haverford, Pennsylvania, January 21 through February 20, 2005; and Ohr-O'Keefe Museum of Art, Biloxi, Mississippi, July 22 through September 10.

Founded in 1994, Zeuxis promotes the genre of still life. The 24 artists who make up the membership come from diverse backgrounds and pursue a variety of artistic styles, but all share an interest in the aesthetic and formal possibilities of still life. The group has mounted more than two dozen exhibitions in a variety of venues, from colleges and university galleries, to small museums and commercial gallery spaces in New York City.
